Local Attractions

1. Mount Congreve Gardens

Situated just 13km from Faithlegg, the world-renowned Mount Congreve Gardens are a haven of tranquillity for plant and nature lovers. Named one of the Great Gardens of the World and featured in The New York Times "52 Places to Go in 2024", they are an unmissable part of any visit to Waterford.

2. Waterford Greenway

Cycle or walk the spectacular Waterford Greenway from the heart of Waterford City to Dungarvan. Journey across eleven bridges, three viaducts and a 400-metre tunnel, following the River Suir through picturesque countryside to the stunning Copper Coast.

3. Waterford Treasures

Step back in time and discover Ireland's oldest city. Explore the award-winning Medieval Museum, Bishop's Palace and the fascinating story of Waterford's Viking origins, rich heritage and world-famous crystal craftsmanship.

4. Copper Coast UNESCO Global Geopark

Stretching for 25km along County Waterford's coastline, the Copper Coast is Ireland's only UNESCO Global Geopark. Enjoy dramatic cliffs, secluded coves, beautiful beaches and breathtaking coastal scenery on one of Ireland's most scenic drives.

5. Dunmore East Cliff Walk

Starting above the picturesque harbour, this beautiful coastal walk offers spectacular sea views, hidden coves and fresh sea air, making it one of Waterford's most popular walking routes.

6. Lafcadio Hearn Japanese Gardens

Located in nearby Tramore, these authentic Japanese gardens celebrate the remarkable life of Patrick Lafcadio Hearn (Koizumi Yakumo), whose writings introduced Japanese culture to the Western world.

7. House of Waterford Crystal

Experience the artistry behind one of Ireland's most iconic brands. Take a guided factory tour and watch master craftspeople create exquisite crystal pieces before browsing the stunning showroom.

8. Mahon Falls & the Comeragh Mountains

Discover the beauty of the Comeragh Mountains with walks suitable for all abilities. Visit Mahon Falls, explore the famous Coumshingaun Lough and take in some of Ireland's most spectacular scenery.

9. Passage East Car Ferry & Hook Peninsula

Take the short ferry crossing from Passage East to County Wexford and explore Hook Head Lighthouse, Tintern Abbey, Loftus Hall and the Dunbrody Famine Ship.

10. Viking Irish Drinks

Just five minutes from Faithlegg, discover Viking Irish Drinks, where award-winning wines, ciders and liqueurs are crafted. Learn about Irish viticulture before enjoying a guided tasting experience.

11. Curraghmore House, Gardens & Distillery

Visit the magnificent Curraghmore Estate, home to the Marquess of Waterford. Explore Ireland's largest private estate, wander through its beautiful gardens and woodland, and discover the estate's whiskey experience, celebrating centuries of heritage and craftsmanship.

12. Dipps Trips Heritage Boat Tours

Experience the River Suir from the water with Dipps Trips, departing from the historic fishing village of Cheekpoint. These guided heritage boat tours showcase the rich maritime history, wildlife and breathtaking scenery of the Waterford Estuary from a unique perspective.

13. Portally Alpaca Trail

Meet the friendly alpacas at Portally Alpaca Farm and enjoy a memorable guided walk through the beautiful Waterford countryside. A wonderful experience for couples, families and animal lovers alike.
